- Identify methods of supporting and developing new and early career principals.

Day 1: Blended Coaching - June 27th 8:00AM-4:00PM

- Develop an understanding of Blended Coaching
- Identify specific language and questioning skills that can be used during coaching sessions.
- Identify ways of moving principals from focusing on doing things to developing new ways of being.
- Identify strategies for planning and preparing for coaching sessions.
- Develop strategies for helping introduce the role of a coach to a new partner.

Day 2: Coaching Practice and Problem Solving - June 28th 8:00AM-4:00PM

- Work with peers to engage in coaching scenarios and receive feedback.
- Develop problem solving skills to help resolve challenging situations that might arise when coaching.
- Develop a plan for personal reflection and session assessment.
