



## RIASP Principal Coaching Requirements for New and Early-Career Principals

Dear Principal,

RIASP is very pleased to offer new and early career Rhode Island principals the opportunity to receive coaching support during the 2019-2020 school year from RIASP veteran principals such as yourself, who will successfully complete a national model of Blended Coaching training facilitated by the Delaware Academy of School Leadership (DASL).

After successful completion of this program, you will be matched with interested new and early career principals and provide 30 hours of one-to-one (on-site and virtual) coaching support to the new principals over the course of the school year.

In addition, new principals will be invited to attend a two-day **New Principal Bootcamp** which will be offered this summer on July 30th and 31st 2019 at RIASP in partnership with DASL. You are invited to attend on the 31st as an opportunity to get to know these new principals. However, it is not mandatory that you attend.

The following are the requirements for a RIASP Principal Coach.

- Attend the Blended Coaching training facilitated by DASL
- 30 coaching hours of one- to -one (on site and virtual)
- Data Collection (after each coaching session) to be submitted to RIASP
- Attend Coach's Seminars = 3 days @ 3 hours each (after school hours)
- Maintaining confidentiality guidelines

Principal Coaches will be paid a stipend of \$700 to be paid at the end of the school year. Thank you, and we look forward to seeing you on June 26th.
